\$25 - General Admission: unallocated seating in general admission sections.


All tickets include the formal presentations and the cocktail reception.

Getting to the venue

The Centre is conveniently located at the heart of the City. To the North, the Centre overlooks the River Torrens and surrounding parklands, while to the South, the Centre sits on North Terrace, one of four major terraces that bind Adelaide’s City Centre.

TRAM: Adelaide is home to an efficient, city-wide transport network, including free tram travel within the City Centre. The closest tram stop is located right in front of the historic Adelaide Railway Station, which is just a two minute walk from the Centre.



TAXI: There are three main taxi companies operate in the Adelaide metropolitan area and can be booked for pick-up or drop-off from the North Terrace and Morphett Street Bridge (West Building) entrances. For guests departing the Centre, a taxi rank is located on North Terrace, right on the Centre’s doorstep. Uber also operates in Adelaide, providing another convenient mode of transport.

Parking

If you are driving to the Centre, the ACC offers two undercover car parking options with both North Terrace and Riverbank car parks. The Riverbank car park is accessible from Morphett Street / Festival Drive.

ACC Parking


Both car parks are located directly under the Centre and operate 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Each is fitted with video surveillance camera systems, and security patrols both areas.

Clearance is 2.0 metres and automated payment stations accept payment via card only (major credit cards, debit cards and mobile pay). Please note that the car parks can reach capacity early in the day during busy events.
